

AAV5 NAb Test

Privacy Notice for Patients and Ordering Physicians

1. Precision for Medicine, Inc., located at 8440 Broadband Drive, Frederick, MD 21701, United States of America (USA) (“Precision”, “We”) collects and processes personal information of:
 - a. Patients tested with the AAV5 NAb Test (“Test”)
 - b. Physicians ordering the Test.

Patients (“Patients”) and ordering Physicians (“ordering Physicians”) are jointly referred to in this notice as “You”/ “Your”.

2. Precision is committed to being transparent about how it collects and processes personal information and to meeting privacy obligations under applicable laws and regulations, in particular, the various Australian federal, state and territory privacy and health record laws that are applicable to You and Precision.
3. In this privacy notice We will explain what data of Yours is being collected for the purpose of the Test, where and how it is going to be processed, how long it will be retained and how You may exercise Your rights connected to the data processing.
4. We have appointed a Chief Privacy Officer (CPO) to oversee compliance with privacy laws. If You have any questions about this privacy notice or about how We handle Your personal information, or if you would like to complain about our handling or your personal information, please contact the CPO: privacy@precisionmedicinegrp.com
5. **Purpose of Processing:**
 - a. The purpose for processing Your personal information is to perform the Test. Your data is indispensable for:
 - i. Ordering the Test to be performed by Precision
 - ii. Precision to receive the test sample
 - iii. Precision to be able to perform the Test and record the Test results
 - iv. Precision to return the Test results
 - b. Your consent to our use of your personal information is obtained by Your physician who shares Your personal information with us as part of the circle of care; or
 - c. If you are an ordering Physician, we collect your personal information on the basis that it is reasonably necessary for carrying out and administering the Test.
6. **What Personal Information Do We Collect and Process?**
 - a. We collect the following data of Patients in connection with the Test:
 - i. First, Middle (optional), and Last name
 - ii. Date of Birth
 - iii. Sex at Birth
 - iv. Health Care Identifier (optional)

- v. Test sample collected from Patients by the requesting ordering Physician
- vi. Results of the Test
- b. We collect the following data of ordering Physicians in connection with the Test:
 - i. First, Middle, and Last name
 - ii. Contact details (phone, fax, email)
 - iii. Name, address, and contact information of the healthcare centre/facility

If you do not provide all the personal information requested, we may not be able to carry out the Test, or the accuracy of the Test may be compromised.

7. How Long is Your Personal Information Retained For?

- a. We will keep the data about You connected to the Test as needed to perform the Test correctly, verify the Test results and communicate the Test results to the ordering Physician.
- b. Your data will be retained for seven (7) years after the result is reported to ensure the possibility of quality check, re-testing, if necessary, and ensuring the ordering Physician has received the Test results.
- c. At the end of the period of retention, mentioned above, Your data will be deleted, unless we are required or authorised to retain the information for longer.

8. Location of Data Processing

- a. Please note that Your data is going to be processed by Precision in the United States of America where data protection legislation may offer less protection to personal data processing. However, Precision undertakes all necessary measures to comply with all relevant and applicable laws. In doing so, Precision has, in particular, implemented appropriate organizational and technical measures to ensure you data is safe, protected from misuse, interference and loss and unauthorised access, modification or disclosure, to ensure it is used only for the purpose it was collected, and to ensure it is retained only for as long as explained in this Privacy Notice.

9. Your Rights

- a. There are rights You have in relation to Your personal information We will hold for these purposes. Which include:
 - i. The right to request access to your information
 - ii. The right to request correction of information that You think is inaccurate
 - iii. The right to withdraw Your consent.

Please note that Precision may not always be able to comply with Your request in full scope since healthcare service and medical diagnostic laws may oblige Precision and/or the ordering Physician to keep Patient personal information connected to the performance of the Test.

10. Recipients

Precision, when necessary, will share Your personal information received with other parties including service providers appointed under a legally binding contract to provide services to Precision which are needed to perform the Test by Precision and maintain appropriate laboratory infrastructure (i.e Precision's sub-contractors).
