Privacy Notice for Patients and Ordering Doctors

1. Precision for Medicine, Inc., located at 8440 Broadband Drive, Frederick, MD 21701, United States of America (USA) (“Precision”, “We”) collects and processes personal data of:
 - a. Patients tested with the AAV5 NAb Test (“Test”)
 - b. Doctors ordering the Test.Patients (“Patients”) and ordering Doctors (“ordering Doctors”) are jointly referred to in this notice as “You”/“Your”.
2. Precision is committed to being transparent about how it collects and processes personal data and to meeting data protection obligations under applicable laws and regulations, in particular, the UK General Data Protection Regulation and its references to the General Data Protection Regulation of the European Union (“GDPR”).
3. In this privacy notice We will explain what data of Yours is being collected for the purpose of the Test, where and how it is going to be processed, how long it will be retained and how You may exercise Your rights connected to the data processing.
4. **The controller of Your personal data is** Precision for Medicine, Inc., located at 8425 Precision Way, Suite M, Frederick, MD 21701, USA.
5. We have appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO) to oversee compliance with data protection laws. If You have any questions about this privacy notice or about how We handle Your personal data, please contact the DPO: privacy@precisionmedicinegrp.com
6. We have a European Economic Area (EEA) and UK Representative who may also be contacted: Krzysztof Mazurek krzysztof.mazurek@precisionmedicinegrp.com
7. **Purpose of Processing:**
 - a. The purpose for processing Your personal data is to perform the Test. Your data is essential for:
 - i. Ordering the Test to be performed by Precision
 - ii. Precision to receive the test sample
 - iii. Precision to be able to perform the Test and record the Test results
 - iv. Precision to return the Test results
 - b. The lawful basis We rely on for processing Your personal data is:
 - i. Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, which relates to processing of data to pursue legitimate interest
 - ii. Article 9(2)(h) of the GDPR, which relates to processing of health-related data necessary to perform medical diagnosis and provide health services.
8. **What Personal Data Do We Collect and Process?**
 - a. We collect the following data of Patients in connection with the Test:
 - i. First, Middle and Last name
 - ii. Date of Birth
 - iii. Sex at Birth
 - iv. Medical Record Number
 - v. Test sample collected from Patients by the requesting ordering Doctor
 - vi. Results of the Test
 - b. We collect the following data of ordering Doctors in connection with the Test:
 - i. First, Middle and Last name
 - ii. Contact details (phone, fax, email)
 - iii. Name, address and contact information of the healthcare centre/facility

9. How Long is Your Personal Data Retained For?

- a. We will keep the data about You connected to the Test as needed to perform the Test correctly, verify the Test results and communicate the Test results to the ordering Doctor.
- b. Your data will be retained for seven (7) years after the result is reported to ensure the possibility of quality check, re-testing, if necessary, and ensuring the ordering Doctor has received the Test results.
- c. At the end of the period of retention, mentioned above, Your data will be deleted.

10. Location of Data Processing

- a. Please note that Your data is going to be processed by Precision in the United States of America, i.e. outside of European Economic Area (EEA) and UK where data protection legislation may offer less protection to personal data processing. However, Precision undertakes all necessary measures to comply with GDPR and, in particular, implementing appropriate organisational and technical measures to ensure you data is safe, protected from unauthorised disclosure, used only for the purpose it was collected, and retained only for as long as explained in this Privacy Notice.

11. Your Rights

- a. There are rights You have in relation to Your personal data We will hold for these purposes. Which include:
 - i. The right to correct information that You think is inaccurate
 - ii. The right to delete Your personal data
 - iii. The right to restrict the processing of Your personal data
 - iv. The right to object to the processing of Your personal data, where We are relying on its legitimate interests as the legal ground for processing Your personal data.

Please note that Precision may not always be able to comply with Your request in full scope since healthcare service and medical diagnostic laws may oblige Precision and/or the ordering Doctor to keep Patient personal data connected to the performance of the Test.

12. Recipients

Precision shall share Your personal data received with necessary parties including processors appointed under a legally binding contract to provide services to Precision which are needed to perform the Test by Precision and maintain appropriate laboratory infrastructure.
